RECRUITMENT NOTICE

District Primary School Council, Jhargram will recruit **two (02) Lower Division Clerk (LDC) and two (02) Group-D posts** in permanent new vacancy approved vide (i) Approval Order issued by School Education Department, Elementary Education Branch memo no.- 508-ES(EE) dt.- 23.11.2022 and (ii) School Education Department, Primary Branch Notification No.- 253-SE(Pry) dt.- 14.03.2007_West Bengal Primary Education (Appointment of staff of Primary School Councils) Rules 2007.

Eligible candidate should apply online in the prescribed format as given in DPSC, Jhargram website (www.dpscjhargram.com) from **06.11.2023, 10:30 A.M. to 15.11.2023, 06:00 P.M.** for the mentioned posts.

Requisite Qualification :

- For Post of Lower Division Clerk (LDC) : Passed Madhyamik Pariksha or its equivalent.
- For Post of Group-D : Passed Class-VIII from a Government recognized Institution.

WILLING CANDIDATES MAY APPLY ONLINE AS PRESCRIBED IN THE WEBSITE AFTER REGISTRATION USING SPECIFIC MOBILE NUMBER & E-MAIL ID. FOR COMPLETION OF REGISTRATION AN OTP WILL BE SENT TO THE REGISTERED MOBILE NUMBER. CANDIDATE WILL CREATE PASSWORD BEFORE SUBMISSION.

NOTE : Candidate must preserve the PASSWORD created by him/her for subsequent login.

INFORMATION REGARDING WRITTEN TEST AND MARKING :-

For post of LDC :

There will be **total 30 (thirty)** MCQ type questions on subjects mentioned in the previous table. **Each question will carry 01 (one) mark for correct answer.** There will be **NEGATIVE MARK** for each **WRONG ANSWER. 0.25 marks will be deducted for each wrong answer.**

For post of Group-D :-

For Reading Skill : There will be **10 (ten) MCQ type questions** based on **Bengali** and **English PARAGRAPHS** given in the question paper. Candidate will have to **read** the paragraph and to answer MCQ type questions. **Each question will carry 01 (one) mark for correct answer.** There will be **NEGATIVE MARK** for each **WRONG ANSWER. 0.25 marks will be deducted for each wrong answer.**

For Writing Skill : One Report/Letter/Short Essay is to be written both in **English** and **Bengali** on the topic mentioned in the question paper. **05 (five) marks** will be allocated for writing in Bengali and **05 (five) marks** will be allocated for writing in English.

Evaluation will be made on the preciseness and correct content of the Report/Letter/Short Essay according to Topic. **Marks will be deducted for Grammatical Mistake, Spelling Error.**

For post of Group - D :- Scanned copy of **ORIGINAL** (i) AADHAAR Card, (ii) Certificate of passing Class-VIII examination issued by School Authority, (iii) Proof of Date of Birth [Birth Certificate/School Leaving Certificate/Admit Card of MP Examination (if available)] (iv) Caste Certificate/Disability Certificate (if applicable) (v) Recent Passport size colour photograph, (vi) Full Signature & (vii) Screenshot of online fund transfer.

2. Age relaxation will be given for the reserved category candidates as per existing norms of the State Government.

- **ADMIT CARD** for appearing at the Written Test mentioning **Date, Time & Venue** is to be uploaded in DPSC website. Applicant will download the Admit Card and print it for appearing in Written Test on specified date, time & venue. **No communication regarding written Test Date, Admit Card issue will be made to individual Applicants.**
- **Applicant will be able to submit Application after successful deposit of Application Fee.**
- The decision of the competent authority regarding the recruitment is final.
- No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates for the selection test/interview.

(A) Click in **LOGIN** button → Signup for **NEW REGISTRATION** → Register → Enter personal details, **mobile number, email-id**, photograph & signature → Enter **Password** (to be created) & **confirm** it → **OTP** will be received in the mobile number provided by the candidate → Click **Register**.

(B) **ONLINE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM AFTER REGISTRATION :-**

Login (using **USER ID & PASSWORD**) → Select **Exam list** (LDC/Group-D) → Submit personal details as per prescribed format in the website → **Upload** documents (as mentioned above) → Click **NEXT** → Deposit **APPLICATION FEE** through **ONLINE MODE** (as prescribed) → Enter **TRANSACTION ID** in the given box → Upload Transaction Screenshot → Click **SUBMIT**.

NOTE :

- (1) After completion of above steps, candidate's application form will be successfully submitted.
- (2) Candidate must be careful to deposit requisite amount of **APPLICATION FEE** (Rs. 300/- /Rs. 150/-) as per his/her reservation **CATEGORY** as prescribed in the Notification. If a candidate deposits **less amount** of application fee as prescribed, his/her application form will be **REJECTED** without any intimation to the candidate.
